E Pay for your plan

- Pay your deposit when you drop your completed sign-up form at Nature's Pantry (open Tues-Sat, 9am-5:30pm). **We encourage you to pay in full if you are able.**
- Nature's Pantry accepts: cash, debit card, Visa and Mastercard
- If you're paying in two installments, your balance is due by the September Harvest Box pick-up day – cash only. (Pay with debit, Visa, or Mastercard at Nature's Pantry BEFORE this date.)
- **Box plan prices include \$20 bin deposit and \$50 service hour deposit.** Deposits are refunded when all bins are returned (May) and service hours are completed.
